CERTIFICATE II IN COMMUNITY SERVICES SUPPORT WORK

CHC20102

This entry level course is designed for participants who want to work in residential facilities and/or in the community under direct or regular supervision within clearly defined organisational guidelines and service plans. Participants who successfully complete the course will gain a nationally recognised CHC20102 Certificate II in Community Services Support Work.



CERTIFICATE II IN COMMUNITY SERVICES (FIRST POINT OF CONTACT)

CHC20302

This entry level course is designed for participants who want to work in roles that support individuals by providing a first point of contact in a crisis situation and referral to a broad range of services. At this level workers provide short-term contact with clients in a crisis situation during which time they establish a helping relationship to define the crisis and provide referral information where appropriate. Participants who successfully complete the course will gain a nationally recognised CHC20302 Certificate II in Community Services (First Point of Contact).



CERTIFICATE III IN COMMUNITY SERVICES WORK

CHC30802

This intermediate level course is designed for participants who want to work in the community services industry. Participants will develop communication skills, counselling, group work, advocacy, community development and other strategies relevant to the community services industry. Participants who successfully complete the course will gain a nationally recognised CHC30802 Certificate III in Community Services Work.
