CERTIFICATE II in HOSPITALITY (KITCHEN OPERATIONS) THH22002

This entry level course is designed for participants who want to work in a commercial kitchen. Participants will learn a range of specialised kitchen skills with emphasis placed on the practical application of cookery principles, implementation of food safety procedures and the presentation of foods for a range of hospitality establishments.

This qualification is flexible and broadly based and is designed to begin careers in a broad range of industry roles including Short Order Cook in a café or small restaurant, Cook in a fast food outlet and Commis Cook.

Participants who successfully complete the course will gain a nationally recognised THH22002 Certificate II in Hospitality (Kitchen Operations).
