Joseph was a strong, happy father of three—proud to provide for his family—until he was dealt a series of blows that left him sick, unable to work and homeless while still trying to provide for his three children on his own.

It was a big deal for Joseph to reach out to someone, to admit he needed help.

But by reaching out and accepting help, we were able to help Joseph find a safe home and learn the parenting skills he needed to raise his kids as a single dad.

Here are some of the ways we can help. If you don't see what you're looking for, please let us know. Together, we'll work out how to get you the support you need.



Housing and accommodation

We help people who are experiencing homelessness or at risk of becoming homeless, get back on track with short or long term accommodation, rent assistance and other support services.



Families and children

Our services focus on early intervention and prevention. We offer counselling, child and parenting support, out of school hours care, family respite, housing and financial education.



Teenagers and young adults

We support young people at risk to build skills for life and access practical support, like help finding a home and connecting with their communities.



Foster care and adoption

Our foster carers provide vulnerable children security, stability and a safe place to call home. We also offer adoption services, respite and permanent care, after care support and mentoring.



Disability support

We're a registered NDIS provider, catering for all levels of care. Services include accommodation, life skills training, respite, home care and home modifications and maintenance.



Mental health and hospitals

We support people through mental illness, addictions, eating disorders and other challenges. Our services include counselling, in-patient and day patient programs, psychiatric support and 24/7 crisis support.



Suicide prevention

Wesley Mission is a trusted leader in suicide prevention. Along with telephone crisis support, we train and empower local communities to help prevent suicide.



Seniors and aged care

Our retirement living and residential aged care facilities provide safe and welcoming communities, while our home care services support people to live independently and comfortably in their own homes.



Support for problem gamblers

Our gambling counselling and community legal services help people who are struggling with the impact of problem gambling and other support services.



Financial literacy

We provide financial counselling to individuals and families in distress, and deliver financial literacy education to help people break the cycle of debt and take control of their finances.



Training and employment

We offer accredited and non-accredited courses including business, aged care, community services, hospitality and outdoor recreation. And we work with employers to train and find employment for job seekers with disability, injury or health conditions.
